ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO PLAN OF OPERATION

The **FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH ASSOCIATION ("FCHA")** submitted to the OFFICE for review and approval, pursuant to and in compliance with Section 627.6488(3), Florida Statutes, amendments to its Plan of Operation.

The Commissioner of the Office of Insurance Regulation, having considered the information submitted by FCHA and being otherwise fully advised in the premises finds:

1. The Commissioner of the Office of Insurance Regulation has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of these proceedings.
2. The **FCHA** has been established in accordance with the provisions of §627.6488, Florida Statutes.
3. Pursuant to §627.6488, Florida Statutes, the **FCHA** shall operate pursuant to a plan of operation approved by the OFFICE.
4. The amended Plan of Operation ("Plan") of the **FCHA** is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
5. The substantive amendments to the Plan establish standards for the conduct of its executive director, board members, senior management, and/or other employees to provide for greater transparency and accountability. The amendments require that the executive director and

senior management be subject to background investigations and that the Florida Division of Insurance Fraud will be notified within 48 hours of any suspected fraud and/or compromise of public trust by any employee or member of the Board. Additionally, a code of ethics regarding conflicts of interest and post-employment restrictions as well as clear guidance to employees as to gifts from and other financial interests in vendors.

6. All of the amendments shall be incorporated herein by reference and not listed specifically in this Order.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby ORDERED:

That all amendments to the Plan of Operation of the **FCHA**, the full Plan of which is attached to this Order with the amendments as Exhibit A, are hereby **APPROVED**.
