Emergency Management (HB 7121) Relating to Prescription Refills

HB 7121 - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT BY DOMESTIC SECURITY

Provides consumers with the ability to purchase early refills of prescription medications in preparation for an impending hurricane. Requires all health insurers, managed care organizations, and other entities licensed by the Office of Insurance Regulation (Office) to waive time restrictions on prescriptions medication refills when the insured resides in a county that: is under a hurricane warning issued by the National Weather Service, is declared a state of emergency issued by the Governor, or has activated its emergency operations center and emergency management plan. Allows the Office, by order, to extend the waiver of refills in 15- to 30-day increments.
