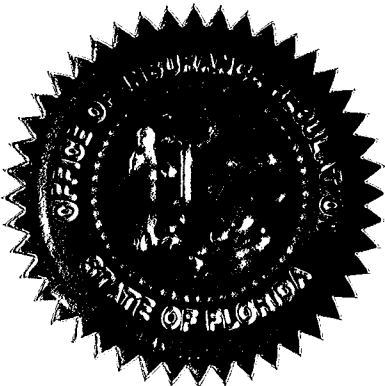



I. GENERAL

A. DEFINITIONS

1. "You," "Your," or "Your Company" shall mean State Farm Florida Insurance Company, State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company and each subsidiary, affiliate or division thereof.

2. "OIR" means the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation.

3. The terms "and" and "or" are terms of inclusion and not of exclusion and shall be construed either disjunctively or conjunctively as necessary to bring within the scope of this subpoena any document or information that might otherwise be construed to be outside its scope.

4. The term "any" includes and encompasses "all" and vice versa.

5. "Relating to" means in whole or in part constituting, containing, concerning, discussing, commenting upon, describing, analyzing, identifying, stating, pertaining to, referring to, or forming the basis of.

6. "Person" includes any natural person, corporate entity, partnership, association, joint venture, government entity or trust, and any other business or legal entity.

7. "Communicate" or "Communication" means every manner or means of disclosure, transfer or exchange, and every disclosure, transfer or exchange of ideas or information, whether orally, by Document, or electronically, or whether face-to-face, by telephone, mail, personal delivery, electronic transmission or otherwise.

8. "Document" shall mean all written or graphic matter, however produced, or reproduced, of every kind and description in Your actual or constructive possession, custody, care or control, including without limitation, all writings, account letters, account

recommendations, appointment books, books of accounts, calendars, CD-ROMs, charts, computer files, computer printouts, contracts, cost sheets, data compilation from which information can be obtained or can be translated through detection devices into reasonably usable form, diaries, drafts, drawings, e-mail, faxes, graphs, hotel charges, invoices, ledgers, magnetic discs, magnetic strips, magnetic tape, memoranda, microfiche, microfilm, minutes, notes, optical characters, papers, photographs, punched cards, punched paper tapes, receipts, recognition characters, reports, sound tapes or recordings, statements, statistical records, stenographer notebooks, studies, telegraphs, time sheets or logs, video tapes or recordings, vouchers, weigh tickets, working papers, and any information related to State Farm Florida Insurance Company's current book of business.

B. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The response to this Demand shall be submitted in the following manner:

1. Documents and information provided shall be complete and un-redacted, submitted as found in Your files.
2. Documents and information requested shall be from a download of computer data to CD, flash drive or external hard drive. Do not convert the Documents and information requested into a spreadsheet.
3. Each CD, flash drive or external hard drive shall include an index of the information it contains.
4. Documents produced electronically shall be non-encrypted.

II. PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

A. INSTRUCTIONS

This Demand for production of Documents calls for the production of all responsive Documents and information in Your possession, custody, or control without regard to the physical location of said Documents or information. This Demand for production is a continuing request.

B. DOCUMENT AND INFORMATION REQUESTED

Produce a download of computer data to CD, flash drive or external hard drive of the following information for each of Your current policyholders by Line of Business (as indicated on page 13 of Your Withdrawal Plan for State Farm Florida Insurance Company).

1. Name
2. Policy Number(s)
3. Billing Address
4. Physical Address of Insured Property
5. Limit of Coverage A
6. Maximum Coverage Provided
7. Annual Premium Amount
8. Renewal Date
9. Whether the Policy Includes Wind Coverage
10. Whether the Policy Includes Windstorm Mitigation Credits
11. Location(s) of Policy Records
