THIS CAUSE is before the FLORIDA OFFICE OF INSURANCE REGULATION ("OFFICE") upon the filing of revised Workers' Compensation Rates and Rating Values by the NATIONAL COUNCIL ON COMPENSATION INSURANCE, INC. ("NCCI"). Following a complete review of the entire record, and upon consideration thereof, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the OFFICE hereby finds as follows:

- 1. On November 1, 2019, the NCCI, in response to the OFFICE's October 24, 2019, initial order, filed revised Workers' Compensation Rates and Rating Values in file log number 19-129377 to modify its original filing of August 27, 2019.
- 2. The revised filing provides for a statewide Workers' Compensation Insurance rate level decrease of 7.5% and contains all other changes referenced in the OFFICE's Order.
