Please refer to the OIR <u>Notice to Industry</u> regarding guidance to insurers about the form and rate filing process for life and health insurance products for the plan year 2021.

These rate filings are publicly available within the <u>IRFS Forms & Rates Filing Search System</u>. Documents marked by the company as trade secret will not be available for review. On the "Advanced Search" tab in IRFS, there is a checkbox for PPACA-compliant filings about halfway down the list (check both boxes). This can be used along with the date fields to get the filings in question. It will return major medical and dental filings.

Additionally, on August 14, 2020, the Centers for Medicaid & Medicare Services (CMS) will post information for consumers to review health insurance rate filings by state that meet the 10% or higher threshold at <u>Healthcare.gov.</u>

As a reminder, the OIR must complete its review of filings with Qualified Health Plans (QHP) in the risk pool by August 26, 2020. This information will become available on the OIR <u>website</u> once finalized.
